Policy Statement

WSC is dedicated to continual improvement in environmental performance through:

1. Conservation of water resources through their effective and efficient use with minimum attainable leakage and losses.
2. Reducing the energy consumption that we use to produce water and to treat wastewater.
3. Ensuring that our impact on the community's environment is minimized as much as possible when conducting essential operations in terms of noise levels and disruption to daily living. We aim also to return the physical environment as closely as possible to its original state.
4. Ensuring the materials, equipment and technology we use are as environmentally friendly as is practically and economically possible.
5. Preventing pollution through sustainable work practices and the effective management of our activities and those of our suppliers, contractors, partners, and trade effluent customers.
6. Protection of the environment and conservation of the marine and other environment.
7. The beneficial reuse of treated sewage and sewage sludge.
8. Reducing the volume of waste produced and maximizing reuse and recycling through proactive waste management.
9. Active involvement in protecting and improving the environment both directly through our operations, and indirectly through active involvement in internal and external initiatives.
10. Reducing loss of amenity to the surrounding areas as far as possible.
11. The use of chemicals in a controlled and environmentally conscious manner by effectively managing the quantity and quality used, storage and disposal activities.
12. Building cooperation with all levels of government, regulators and other interested parties while complying with all relevant compliance obligations.
13. Educate consumers in water conservation, prevention of blockages and quality of effluents.
